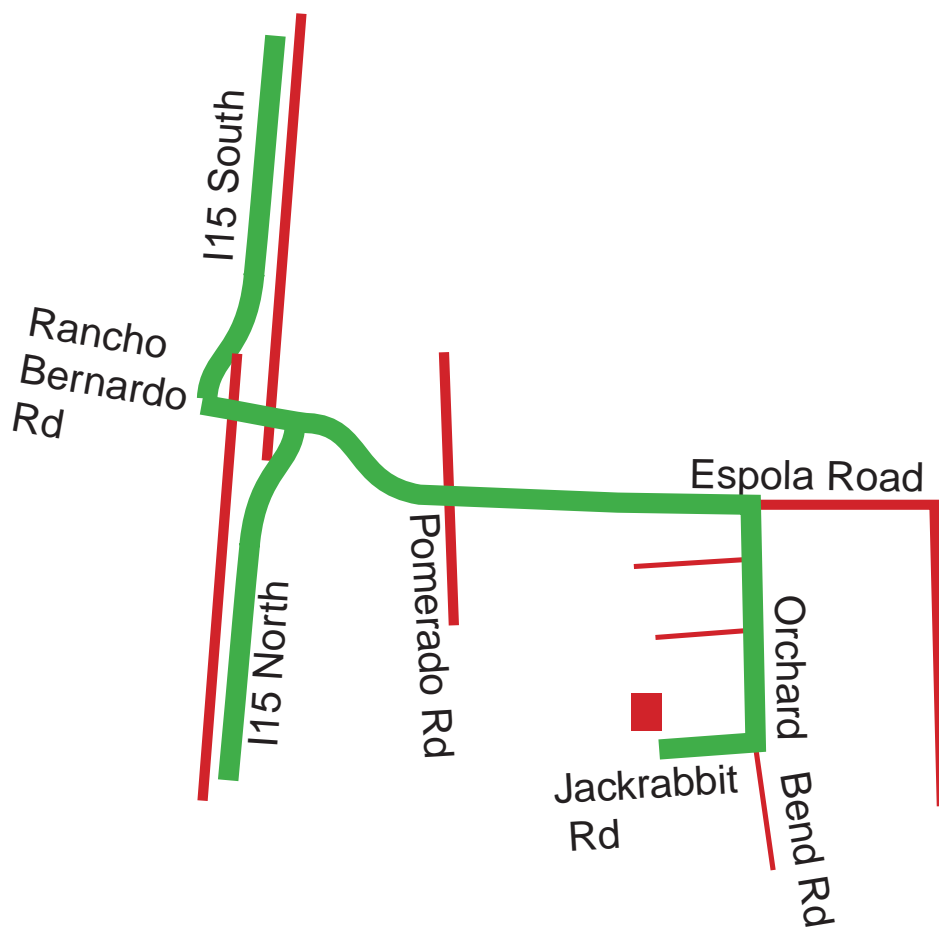

The annual picnic has been highlighted by the woodturning contest. The last couple of contests featured turned spoons and open turnings from a specific block of wood. The contest really brings out the creativity in our member turners.

There is a change in the raffle venue for this year’s picnic. The prizes for the raffle will be special turnings made just for this raffle by some of the advanced and professional turners in the Club. A three piece set of nested bowls by Mike Mahoney heads the list. The proceeds of this special raffle are earmarked for the memorial to Don Owen’s dad, Waldo Owen. The San Diego Woodturners donated and planted six Liquidamber trees at Don’s school in his Dad’s honor. The price raffle tickets will be doubled (\$ 2.00 each) for this raffle only.
