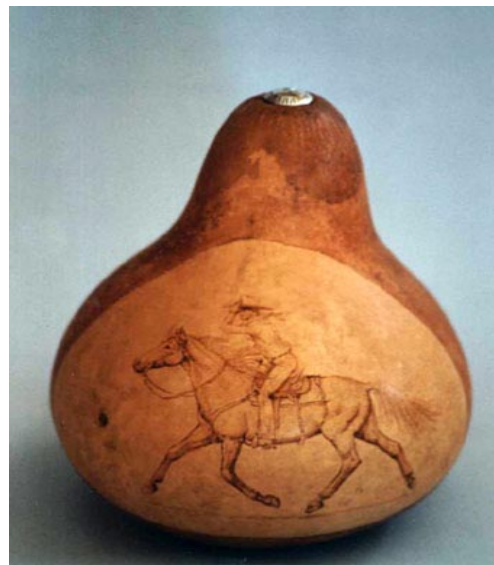

GALLERY 21 IS ALMOST HERE!

This is the last call for participation in our annual Gallery 21 exhibition in the Spanish Village in Balboa Park. The Gallery will be open from November 30 through December 15. Having the Gallery during the first two weeks of December is different than past years. This means that we will be open during **Christmas on the Prado** (December 7th and 8th). The show will also feature the Turning of the Year by Horst Remmling.

So start building your inventory. Each person is allowed to have up to three pieces or three small collections of pieces. If one or more of your entries is a collection, you may have up to twelve like items. A collection would be like a set of pens, a set of Christmas ornaments, etc. Each piece or collection must be no larger than 15" x 15". Height is limited to the ceiling height in the room. Remember that only current Club members as of July 1, 2001, will be allowed to participate.

Don Kaufmann is coordinating the work schedules. He will need people to help set up, staff the show and clean up at the end. Show set-up and check-in will be November 30th. Opening will be on December 1st. The last day of the show will be December 14th, with clean-up and pick-up on December 15th.

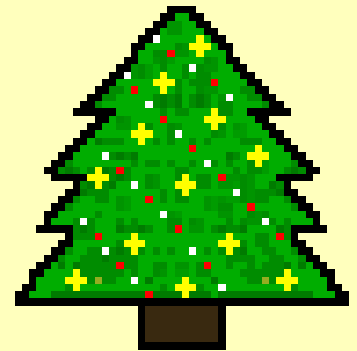

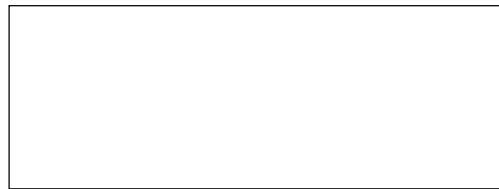
