Stuart Batty and Dick Sing Returns to the Woodturning Centre

As a quick reminder, the San Diego Woodturning Centre is hosting **Stuart Batty** for five days of instruction during the week of July 22nd and **Dick Sing** for a Saturday demonstration and three days of instruction from August 10 through August 13.

Stuart will give his two-day techniques class which includes spindle turning and face turning, as well as the proper use of the roughing gouge, skew, spindle gouge, parting tool and bowl gouges.

Stuart's three-day project class includes sphere turning, deep and thin bowl turning, square bowls, long-stem goblets and natural edge bowls.

Dick Sing will focus on inlaid boxes, off-center turning and other smaller items.

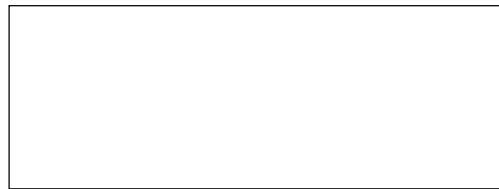
