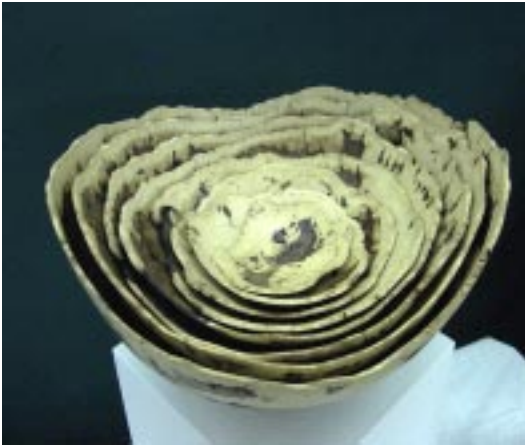
Scrap Wood and Shorts Garage Sale

demonstration schedule, he finds time to present at the annual Utah Woodturning Symposium in Provo and is a regular instructor at the Craft Supplies

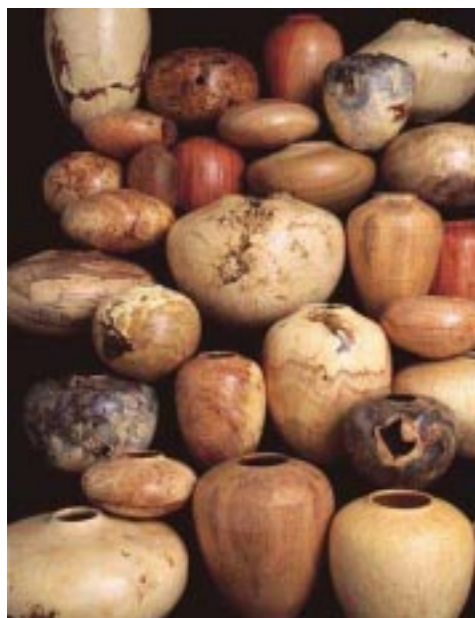
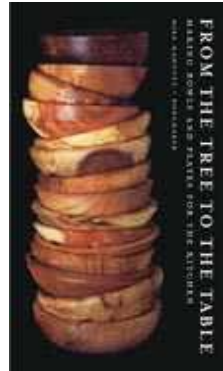

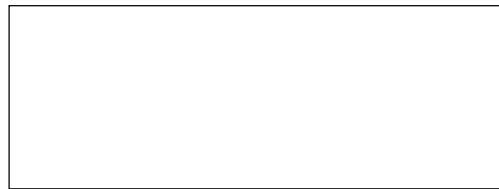
