## Shop Safety

**What Things You Should Do in Your Shop  
– Or NOT!**

Have you ever approached a piece you were turning and had misgivings about the tool selection, tool angle, or lathe speed? Have you ever been hurt because you didn't pay attention to a natural edge bowl's high spot? Have you ever cut yourself on a tool while testing for sharpness? Well, if you have encountered these or any other safety issue, the January meeting is for you. We will have several people discuss their safety problems and explain how they overcame them. They will also answer your questions regarding how to turn more safely. Finally, everyone will be invited to related their safety problems or precautions for the benefit of the entire club.

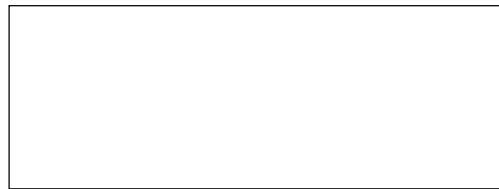
