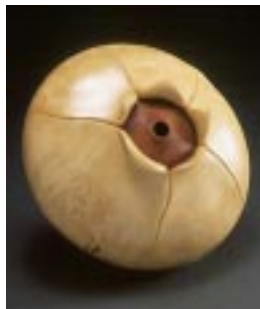
FROM THE PREZ

taught us more about the chain saw than we knew existed. I have used a chain saw for years, but I learned so much from Don that night that I am still amazed. Did you know that the slot for the chain travel in the bar can become splayed with wear, hence the chain won't run in the groove correctly and becomes not only wobbly, but dangerous? Turning the bar over from time to time (like turning your mattress over once a month) can prevent this. Another jewel, did you know that in a pinch, you can NOT substitute regular motor oil for your gas mix oil? You can ruin your engine! Speaking about the mixture oil, Husky chain saws require a mix of 50:1 (gasoline to oil) and that not all of the oil you buy is so formulated. You need to buy a good grade of oil with the appropriate formulation or you may ruin or shorten the life of your engine. So many pearls, one after another through the evening. My thanks to Don, for such a great learning experience. I was glad the Husqvarna rep didn't come.

The next meeting will be Trent Bosch, the master of illusion. I think you will be rewarded to sit at his feet and learn some of his tricks and technics. Trent is coming under the sponsorship of The Turning Center.

I neglected to mention, that I think the raffle was "fixed" as the raffle chairman, Warren Sherman, won the big prize (just kidding, of course). Of course, I doubt that he will be able to use the prize (a Husqvarna chain saw), as Don used it in his demonstration and had taken it all apart and probably didn't get it back together! There were extra pieces on the floor that we neglected to pick up, as we were anxious to get home and see what we were bombing in Iraq.

## Design in Wood Exhibit at the San Diego County Fair

It is not too early to be thinking about the San Diego County Fair (formerly known as the Del Mar Fair). Once again, the San Diego Woodturners will have a demonstration booth in the corner so that we can help to show what we do to the public. Our booth is always one of the most popular attractions in the Design in Wood Exhibit. Hours of operation will be 10am to 2pm and 2pm to 6pm. These shifts are every day. Two people per shift is best. The Fair starts June 13<sup>th</sup> and runs through July 6<sup>th</sup>. Please call Chuck Luebbers or Lorin Youde for additional information or to sign up. You will receive two free passes to the Fair for every shift that you work. You will also receive free Green lot parking for every day that you work which includes a shuttle to and from the exhibit with your tools.

You should also be starting on your entries into the Fair. There will be over \$15,000 of prizes awarded in 21 categories. There will be four turning categories again this year: center work, face work, embellished work and segmented turnings. You may enter a total of three pieces into the exhibit. Entries must be post-marked on or before May 2<sup>nd</sup>. Actual works are due at the Fairgrounds on May 31<sup>st</sup> between 10am and 5pm. Pick-up will be on July 7<sup>th</sup>. between noon and 8pm. The entry fees will be the same as last year, \$15 per piece. Rules and regulations will be available at the March meeting. 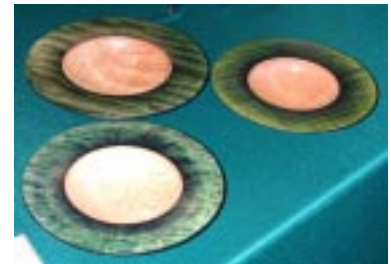

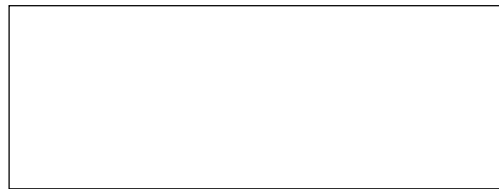
