Take a Turn Saturday June 25th

For our June meeting, we will be hosting our third summertime "Take-a-Turn". What is a Take-a-Turn? Take-a-Turn is where everyone present turns. This is not a demonstration. This is hands-on turning where we share ideas, receive assistance with turning problems, pontificate about Ken Roth's turning style, and try to determine if Pete Campbell owns any shoes.

The focus of this "Take-a-Turn" will be bowls. Everyone will have the opportunity to turn or rough a bowl before leaving. Mentors will be present to help you with the finer points of tool control, wood orientation, bowl design, and chucking. We will also have sharpening stations to help with grinding.

Please don't feel limited to bowls, however. Bring any question or issue with you. Our mentors will provide all the assistance you need.

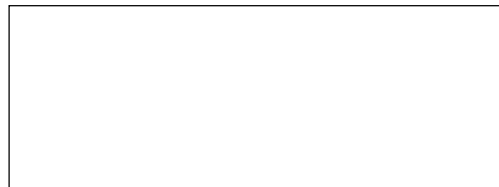
